WHEREAS, the corporate authorities request the opinion of the citizens of the Village of Plymouth on the question of an appointed Village Clerk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF PLYMOUTH, HANCOCK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The corporate authorities shall submit the following advisory question of public policy to the voters of the Village of Plymouth:

“Shall the clerk in Plymouth be appointed, rather than elected?”

Section 2: The corporate authorities shall submit this question of public policy to the voters of the Village of Plymouth at the Consolidated Election to be held on April 7, 2015.
